Choose "New Student Registration for 2022-2023 School Year"

**NOTE - If your child is currently enrolled in our PUF program, you will need to wait to receive a snapcode from the office prior to registering.

As a newcomer, you will be required to create an account. If you currently have a student within PRSD, you will Sign In to your existing account.

Choose New Student Registration 2022-2023 and follow the steps to completing the online registration form.

Once you have registered, please call the school and ask about Kindergarten Camp.

<u>Most importantly</u>, please provide the office with a copy of your child's birth certificate or other form of citizenship record.

To that end, I am happy to report that we have four teachers within the school division that are volunteering their time to teach Ukrainian students through virtual lessons.
