As a newcomer, you will be required to create an account. If you currently have a student within PRSD, you will Sign In to your existing account.

I cannot believe the school year is already coming to an end, it seemed to fly by! Springfield Elementary was able to accomplish many of our goals for Indigenous Education. We recognized and honoured Truth and Reconciliation Day, participated in the Roc Your Mocs campaign, welcomed many guest storytellers to the school, piloted our grade 4 Indigenous Girls Group, began Indigenous murals throughout the school, and ended with an amazing National Indigenous Peoples Day!

Earlier this year we were awarded a grant through the Truth and Reconciliation Committee. The grant is for schools to help fulfill the TRC's Calls to Action. Our school decided to use the grant to commission an Indigenous artist to paint murals throughout the school. The murals will feature the Seven Sacred Teachings and be written in Cree, Dene, Michif, French and English. It is important that Indigenous culture be represented in schools, so Indigenous students see themselves as belonging and for non-Indigenous students to build allyship. We are very lucky to have parent and artist Elvis Thomas agree to paint our murals, thank you Elvis!!

Sadly, this will be my last week at Springfield, as I move on to focus on my last year of my education degree. I have adored teaching and mentoring students and cannot wait to be back in the classroom. I hope that my short time as Indigenous Support Worker has made an impact for students, I know it has definitely impacted me as an educator! Thank you and have a wonderful summer!
