SUPERINTENDENT'S MESSAGE: PARENT SURVEYS

These survey results are important. PRSD values your feedback, as we endeavor to continually improve our services for our students. By completing these surveys, you will be helping us be the first choice for students.

Thank you in advance for taking the time to fill out the surveys and for returning them to the government on our behalf. Your support, along with our hardworking staff members, has allowed us to continue operations throughout a difficult school year.

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I would also like to take this time to highlight our achievements and showcase some of the great things we've been implementing within the Division this school year:

- We've committed to ongoing student assessments and creating individual academic profiles for each student. To enhance this, our Learning Services team partnered with school staff to administer Early Years Assessments over 30 days covering classes in seven schools throughout the Division.
- We have continued to prioritize safety for our students and staff in classrooms, as well as online. New procedures and technological safety measures have been implemented to ensure everyone in the Division feels safe.
- Emotional supports are readily available to students to create a safe learning environment in classrooms and schools. Students and staff have access to Social Workers, YES Workers, Project PEACE team members and many other divisional supports.
- Parental involvement has steadily increased, especially in regard to School Councils and the Council of School Council meetings. Professional development with the Alberta School Council Association has assisted us in creating more opportunities for parents to work more closely with the Division and their schools.

All schools are making sure that their students' physical, social, and emotional wellness needs are met so that their overall academic engagement is increased.

We are looking forward to a successful year ahead and we thank you in advance for completing the survey.
