Our Transportation Department will be removing all students from current Bus Routes for the 2023-2024 school year and will not be rolling over registrations from the previous year. This is in order for the Department to create new Bus Routes to meet the new Provincial Eligibility Requirements.

Parents/Guardians MUST fill out the updated school bus registration information on the Returning Student Update form prior to June 30th, or the student will not be registered on a bus for the 2023-2024 school year, which will result in a delay of service for those students.

New Provincial Eligibility Requirements:

- Kindergarten to Grade 6 - Student Resides more than 1.0 kilometers from their designated school

- Grade 7 to 12 - Student Resides more than 2.0 Kilometers from their designated school

A *returning student* is one who was enrolled in a PRSD school on the last day of the previous school year.

#### \*Note that parents of returning students will receive a code from their school to update and validate their registration information at a later date

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

#### SHELTER IN PLACE:

Used when personal safety is considered to be in danger if anyone leaves the building. This is mainly used for environmental, weather-related events, or wildlife risks. It can also be used in case of a system failure i.e. a Chemical Release. Everyone must remain in the building and may or may not be able to move ( freely within the building (instruction may continue); all exterior doors and windows should be closed and locked, and the exterior doors should be monitored to ensure no one leaves the building until local/school authorities advise that conditions are safe.

This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
