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Did you know.... Bus Notes are required when riding a bus that a student is not registered to or to get off at a different location?

When a parent requests that their child be dropped off at a location other than their home, a bus note must be submitted by the school only. The parent needs to call the school their child attends at least 24 hours in advance to request a bus note. The school will then complete the Transportation Note for the bus driver, sign it, and email it to the Transportation Office. The note will be handed to the driver on the day the alternate drop-off is requested.

No other notes will be accepted.

In case of an emergency within the 24-hour period, the parent must contact the Transportation Office directly to request a Transportation Note for the bus driver.
